Charitable Organisations Policy

Registered Charitable Organisations in Trinidad and Tobago can apply to the Trinidad and Tobago Multistakeholder Group (TTMAG) for a third level domain under charity.tt (i.e. yourname.charity.tt) at **no cost** by completing the online form at <https://forms.gle/8nuNJMCJBtRWov7Z7> .

Information on how an organisation can become a registered charitable organisation in Trinidad and Tobago can be found at [tconnect](https://tconnect.gov.tt).

1. **Information needed by TTMAG.**

The Charitable Organisation (CO) needs to submit to TTMAG :

- (a) The CO's proof of legitimacy in Trinidad and Tobago as a registered charitable organisation.
- (b) The CO's evidence of validity of charitable status.
- (c) If the domain name application is being submitted by a third party acting on behalf of the CO, official documentation from the CO which authorises the third party to act on behalf of the CO.

2. COs must agree to be bound by TTNIC's [Terms and Conditions](#) and [Policies](#)
3. TTMAG reserves the right to review and if required recommend to TTNIC termination of the assigned domain at any time.
4. Assigned domains shall be for an automatically renewable duration of three (3) years unless there is clear evidence of inactivity or inappropriate use as determined by the TTMAG.
5. Assigned domains shall be for a duration of three (3) years. Before the end of the three year term, COs are required to submit updated proof that they are still a CO.

COs that do not submit proof of Charitable status every three years will not have their domain renewed.

This policy was created and approved by the Trinidad and Tobago Multistakeholder Advisory Group (TTMAG ; <https://mag.tt>) in 2017 and was updated in 2022.
